

## We're back with some exciting news!

HERhealthEQ in partnership with Lutech Industries, have officially launched our 10-for-10 project: 10 colposcopes in 10 countries! The deployment of 100 Lutech Medical LT-300 colposcopes will be sent to medical clinics and hospitals in 10 different regions, including Costa Rica, Egypt, Fiji, Ghana, Lebanon, Mexico, Romania, South Africa, Zambia. 85% of cervical cancer deaths occur in low and middle income countries, but when detected early, the survival rate is 92%. **When fully deployed, HERhealthEQ will be able to screen 480,000 women a year for Cervical Cancer.** Visit the [website](#) to learn more and donate.
